## **Advanced Apprenticeship IT:**

This framework meets the needs of learners who are already employed in an IT user role. The framework provides learners with a cohesive suite of qualifications that will enable them to develop a solid understanding of how to work and communicate in any business environment. The framework will help learners to generate the required knowledge alongside practical skills to ensure reliable standards of competence and skills that are relevant and specific to the organisation. The framework includes two components (A) Diploma for IT Users and (B) Functional Skills

### **(A)Level 3 Diploma for IT Users**

This qualification gives the learner the opportunity to develop a broad skill set that will facilitate progression in the workplace and/or onto further learning. This qualification includes Mandatory and Optional units.
